The foundations of a strong community are being laid at Esperance as construction work progresses quickly on the first building, Esprit.

Locals and keen future residents have already noticed the new tower crane which has been erected onsite and will remain so until the build's first stage is completed in mid-2022.

The recent completion of the ground floor slab pour marks a major milestone in the construction of Esprit. With this slab in place the focus has shifted to the building's vertical elements, including the podium's supporting columns and the stair and lift shafts which have all emerged from ground level.
